## SECTION A (30 MARKS)

- Q1. (a) The beautiful scenery created by a water garden demands that the water remains clear. Explain the major challenges to water clarity and the possible (6 marks)
- (b) Outline the considerations to make in the choice of a site for a water garden (5 marks)
- Q2. (a) Every ornamental garden requires some maintenance aspects to enhance a beautiful scenery. Discuss the maintenance aspects that should be observed in (6 marks)
- (b) Without having to measure the amount of soil moisture in a turf area, what would guide the turf grass manager on when to irrigate his turf (2 marks)
- (c) A terrarium is like a miniature forest floor. Justify this statement (2 marks)

- Q3. (a) A rock garden is intended to be a true representation of a natural rock scenery. Outline the considerations one needs to make in the site selection in order to achieve this objective (5 marks)
- (b) Using at least one example, outline the groups of plants used in a rock garden
  (4 marks)

- Q4. (a) The beauty of house plants can emanate from their foliage, shapes or flowers. Using specific examples, describe the various shapes of house plants

- (b) Outline the features of a container that would make it qualify for use in a terrarium (5 marks)
- (c) It is always advisable never to remove more than 40% of the leaf area in any lawn mowing. Justify this statement (3 marks)
- Q5. (a) As a newly recruited golf course manager for a yet to be established facility made of fine turf, describe the various methods you would use in establishing the facility (15 marks)
- (b) Describe the guiding principles for locating hanging baskets for interior scaping (5 marks)
- Q6. (a) Justify the use of plants in landscaping highlighting the possible challenges this may pose to any given landscape (10 marks)
- (b) Turf grass has been commonly used in various ornamental gardens. Outline the limitations of their use and the morphological and/or anatomical features that make mowing relevant as its maintenance procedure (5 marks)
- (c) Outline the relevance of ground covers in any given landscape (5 marks)
