- (b) Cosmogony; and
- (c) Eschatology.
- 3. (a) State and explain the kinds of questions that ontology engages in!
- (c) Highlight the ontologies of Heraclitus, Parmenides, Plato, and Aristotle!
- 4. (a) Briefly define the following: theism, deism, monotheism, atheism, polytheism, and pantheism!
- (b) Outline the general characteristics of the cosmological and design arguments for God's existence!
- (c) Show how the argument from evil attempts to challenge the existence of God!
- 5. (a) Define mind within the context of metaphysics!
- (b) Explain the significance of the notion of intentionality in relation to consciousness!
